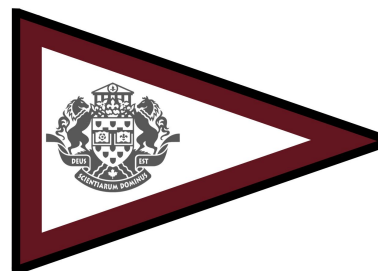


**University of Ottawa Invitational Regatta  
September 14th and 15th 2019**



**Notice Of Race**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Sail Canada and CICSA will apply.
- 1.3 This will be a 2-Division, rotational event. The collegiate dinghy class will be split into two fleets, A and B.
- 1.4 The Organizing Authority is the University of Ottawa Sailing Club in partnership with the Nepean Sailing Club.

**2 ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the *Club 420* class.
- 2.2 Charter boats will be supplied to competitors free of charge by the University of Ottawa and the Nepean Sailing Club.
- 2.3 CICSA teams, as governed by the *CICSA Constitution and By-laws* (and subsequent eligibility), are eligible for entry.

- 3.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup> is 10:00am.

- 3.4** The final warning signal on Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup> will be no later than 3:00pm

#### **4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be emailed to participating teams prior to the event and available on the day of the regatta.

#### **5 VENUE**

The Ottawa University Invitational will be held at the Nepean Sailing Club, 3259 Carling Avenue Ottawa, ON. The regatta will be run out of the NSC Sailing School which can be accessed by going through the main club house and is situated across the boat yard in between the two dinghy T-docks and launch ramps. Racing will take place on Lac Deschenes.

#### **6 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**6.1** The penalties are as follows:

**6.2** For the Collegiate Dinghy Class, rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

#### **7 SCORING**

**7.1** The scoring system is as follows:

**7.2** The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A, excluding A2)

**7.3** 12 races are scheduled for the weekend (for each of A and B division), 2 races are required to be completed in each division to constitute a series.

#### **8. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS**

**8.1** Protests and requests for redress shall be written on the provided Protest Forms. Protest Forms are available with the Race Committee Representative on shore. Protests shall be filed within 30 minutes of the last boat reaching the rotation site after the set in which the incident occurred.

**8.2** Protest hearings will take place as soon as possible. The hearing schedule and location of hearings will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board.

**8.3** In accordance with rule 70.5 (a), decisions of the protest committee are final.

#### **9 SUPPORT BOATS**

#### **10 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the Nepean Sailing Club.
